



Premier Basketball Tournament Rules

1. **National High School Federation rules** will be followed with the few exceptions listed below:
2. **Game Length:** (6th thru HS = two 22-minute running clock halves) Clock will stop last 1-minute of first half – and last 2 min of second half - Except if team is up by 16pts or more in last 2 minutes of game.
3. **Shot clock:** There will be NO shot clocks. Please do not stall.
4. **Fouls:** Each player will be allowed a total of 6 fouls before being disqualified.
5. **Timeouts:** Teams will be allowed to call (4) 30 second timeouts per game.
6. **Warmup and halftime:** There will be a minimum of three (3) minute warmup and two (2) minute break between halves.
7. **Technical and Intentional fouls:** results in automatic 2pts and ball out of bounds.
8. **Overtime:** 1st overtime is 2 minutes, 2nd overtime is 1 minute, 3rd overtime is first team to 2 points. One 30-second timeout per OT, there is NO carryover of timeouts from regulation.
9. **Jersey Color:** Away team is listed first in pool play games and at the bottom of bracket play and will wear dark color uniforms.
10. **Seedings:** Seedings from each pool will be determined by the following order:
 - Win-Loss record in pool play.
 - (2 teams tied) Head to head determines seeding. If no head to head, will move to point system.
 - (3 or more teams tied) Point system determines seeding.
 - There is a maximum of +/- 20pts per game. All games in pool play are included in figuring point system. In case 3 teams are still tied, the least amount of points allowed will determine higher seed. Still a tie, a coin toss will determine seeding.
11. **Players/Coaches/Spectators Behavior:**

Premier Basketball will NOT tolerate any abusive language, or violence of any kind. Any behavior deemed inappropriate may result in dismissal from the tournament. We ask coaches/directors to monitor their player/spectator's behavior.

The Tournament Directors will have the final say regarding any disputes
