I want those ladies to get recruited as much as you do! With that in mind I want to provide you with some information. (Disclaimer: Information provided is simply my opinion and should be taken as such.)

We have commitments from local colleges to attend the Shamrock in person. I will do my part by inviting them to be our guests, providing VIP credentials, free food/drinks. 😊

Thanks to the Pandemic the recruiting process is modernized. With streaming services, coaches all over the country can tune in to see players. We have seen 44 coaches log in to take in games. This is a game changer because they can get a first early look at kids. Additionally, they can review film in the comfort of home or office.

[BallerTV](#) gives you the opportunity to fill in a team roster Your players can complete [Athlete Check-in](#). It will associate you with a team, collect data and make the film more valuable. Information is compiled and made available to recruiting services, and schools that subscribe. With all the awesome teams we have participating in Shamrock this year, there will absolutely be schools tuning in. Make it easy for them to connect with your kids and families.

The future of the service: Your team's bookkeeper will be an important part of the process. It is in your best interest to provide a tech savvy person, to put the information in the iPad. When you populate the traditional scoresheet, we update the event pools and brackets and trash them at the end. But when you populate Baller iPad that information lives on in the system and may be used 9-12 months beyond the end of the Shamrock. Current state: At the minimum we want the book person to start the stream when the game starts, update the final score, at game end. In the future they will have an opportunity to really help "Sally Superstar". If she averages a triple double, that information can be captured on the iPad if they are up to the task. It would be cool if they could manage offensive and defensive rebounds, steals, blocks, etc.

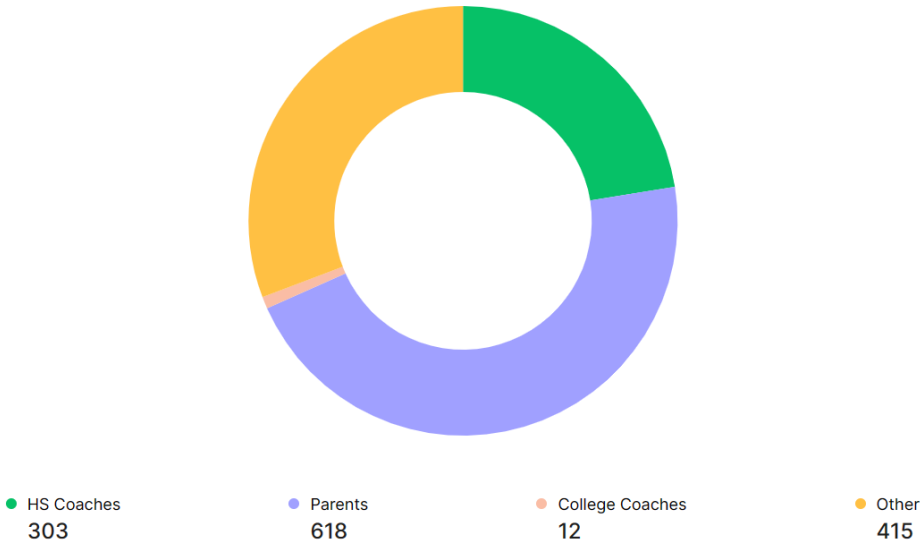

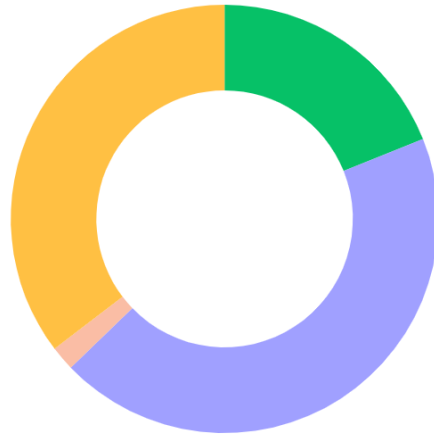
