

# OK FADEAWAY HOOPS 3v3 FALL LEAGUE

## Official Game Rules

### League Format

- 3-on-3 half-court play using one basket.
- Teams may have 4–5 players (3 players on the court).
- One 16-minute stop-clock game.
- First team to 30 points wins immediately.
- If tied at the end of regulation, the first team to score one (1) point in overtime wins.
- No mercy rule.

### Scoring

- Inside the Arc = 1 Point
- Behind the Arc = 2 Points
- Free Throw = 1 Point

### Possession

- After a Made Basket: The non-scoring team starts underneath the basket. The ball must be dribbled or passed behind the three-point arc before attempting to score. If passed, the defense may not intercept while inside the protected area. If dribbled, the defense may not steal until the ball handler exits the protected area. Once outside, normal defense begins.
- After a Defensive Rebound or Steal: Clear the ball behind the three-point arc before attempting to score.
- After an Offensive Rebound: Play continues immediately without clearing the ball.

### Fouls

- Team fouls accumulate throughout the game.
- Team Fouls 7–9: One-and-One.
- Team Fouls 10+: Two Free Throws and Possession.
- Technical & Unsportsmanlike Fouls: Two Free Throws and Possession.
- Free Throws: Shooter uses the free throw line. All other players remain outside the three-point line and above the free throw-line extended. Players may pursue the rebound immediately after release.

### Timeouts & Substitutions

- One 60-second timeout per team.
- Substitutions may only be made during dead balls before the check-ball.

### Uniforms

- Official reversible jerseys provided by OK Fadeaway Hoops.
- Home Team: Light Side.
- Away Team: Dark Side.
- Players must provide basketball shorts.
- Basketball shoes are required.
- Jewelry prohibited except as permitted under NFHS rules.

### Player Eligibility

- Grade-based eligibility system.
- Players may play up but may not play down.
- Coaches are responsible for player eligibility.

## **Standings & Tie-Breakers**

- 1. Head-to-Head
- 2. Total Points Scored
- 3. Fewest Points Allowed
- 4. Point Differential

## **Protests**

- Only rule interpretations may be protested.
- Judgment calls are final.
- Notify the Site Director immediately.
- \$100 protest fee required.
- Player eligibility protests must be made before the game begins.
- Video must be presented within 30 minutes after the game.

## **Official Score**

- The official scoresheet is the official record of the game.
- If the scoreboard differs, the official scoresheet prevails.

## **Sportsmanship**

- Players, coaches, parents, and spectators are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in technical fouls, ejections, forfeitures, suspension, or removal from league play.
