



## Phoenix Basketball Spring League Rules & Regulations

- The PBL will be using FIBA RULES to govern all games.
- Stop Time, (4x) 8 Minute Quarters.
- 24 Sec Shot Clock (Grades 8 - 12)
- Home Team = White or Light Coloured Uniforms  
Away Team = Black or Dark Coloured Uniforms
- Warm up time for each game will be (3 - 5) minutes unless otherwise directed by a member of the Phoenix Committee.
- Half time will be (2) minutes unless otherwise directed by a member of the Phoenix Committee.
- Overtime will be 2 mins. Stop time last (1) minute.
- Each teams must have a min. of 5 players to begin the game otherwise a forfeit with a negative 15 points will be issued to the short handed team after the 15 minute grace period has expired.
- A forfeit is recorded as Loss (L) negative -10 points (EX: L -10) for the forfeited team.
- **Mercy Rule:** If a team is losing by 30+ points n the 4th quarter at the 1:00 minute mark, the game will be called.
- A 15 minute grace period after the scheduled game time will be given to a late team before a forfeit is issued to the team. If the team(s) shows up within that 15 mins grace period the game time will start immediately and the first half will be run time.
- Each team will have 4x timeouts for the game. 2 timeouts in the second half.
- The ball can advance to half court if a time out is called in the last 2 minutes of the game.
- Bonus will be in affect after 5 team fouls have been committed by a team. (2 shots)
- 5 personal fouls will result in a player being fouled out.
- If a team has a player or players not in their teams matching jersey, that team will receive a technical foul. Shot at half time (Effective Session #2).



## Phoenix Basketball Spring League Rules & Regulations

- Our Phoenix (PBL) Committee makes all final decisions concerning all grievances; i.e. protests, eligibility, etc.
- No team shall have a player roster of more than 15 players. Note: Only 12 medals/trophies for the top two (2) teams will be awarded per division.
- All players must wear gym shoes and matching coloured t-shirts/jerseys with legible numbers when playing.
- Roster must be submitted to the PBL Committee before the first game. No adding players after the first game has been played unless otherwise directed by a member of the Phoenix Committee.
- If a team fails to submit their roster on time only the players on the scoresheet of their 1st game will be allowed to play for the remainder of the season. No adding players after the first game.
- A team will be charged with a forfeit if it uses an ineligible player that is not on the roster. The coach is responsible for ensuring the eligibility of all players on their team. To avoid unnecessary forfeits please allow for **30 minutes** before your first scheduled game to make sure your roster is submitted in full.
- Destruction or damage of any property will be punished by authorities being called. The player and/or team will pay for damages and may be **eliminated** from the League.
- A player can play up if it is their SAME SPORTS/CLUB as their original team. Other than this situation no player can play on more than one team during the season. If this rule is violated, all relevant games will be forfeited and will result in a loss for any team associated with this player.
- The PBL has no tolerance for fighting. **Fighting by any individual (either on or off the court) will result in the individuals involved being ejected from the game and/or suspend for 2 game. A 2nd altercation from any individual from the previously incident can result in that player or team's removal from the PBL .**



# Phoenix Basketball Spring League Regulations

- The team's coach/manager(s) are the voice of their team and are responsible for the conduct of their team and guests. If any player or spectator appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Game officials have the right to expel players, coaches and/or guests from any game should this rule be broken. The Phoenix Committee may bar any coach/player and/or guest from the gym at their discretion. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**
- No smoking/drinking is permitted while on the premise and/or within 15 feet of any of the entrance doors. Any persons caught violating this code of conduct will be removed from the League.
- **It is the coaches responsibility to have players student ID present. Remind your players to have their student ID cards with them. If questioned by (PBL) Committee a player can not play until their age is confirmed.**
- Tie breakers are decided by the winner of the head to head match up. If two teams played twice and are 1 - 1 then the tie breaker goes to the team that has the greater winning margin in points.
- A team must play a minimum of 8 games to be eligible for the PBL Playoffs.
- If a player on your team choses to dunk the ball then it is your responsibility for the team to cover the cost of any damages.

## Game Play Basketball Sizes

Size 5 or 27.5 will be the official basketball size for U9 - U12.

Size 6 or 28.5 will be the official basketball size for U13 - U14.

Size 7 or 29.5 will be the official basketball size for U15 - U19.

Please Note: The U14 Boys Platnium division will use the Size 7 Basketball.
