



# BEACH CITY BASKETBALL

## 2026 HS Summer Team Camp – Official Rules

- The team listed second on the Beach City Basketball App is the HOME team. The HOME team should be prepared to wear a light/white colored uniform/jersey top. The team listed first on the schedule is the AWAY team. The AWAY team should be prepared to wear a dark/black colored uniform/jersey top. Download the Beach City Basketball App to stay up to date for scores/standings etc.
- The timing of our event is extremely important. For us to have a successful event, all of our games need to start on time. Plan to be at each gym location at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start of each game. Teams that do not have a member of the coaching staff and at least 5 players at the scheduled start of the game will have to forfeit.
- All games will consist of two (2) twenty (20) minute halves. The clock will continuously run, except for the last minute of the first half and last two minutes of the second half. If the winning team is leading by 20 points, or more, the clock will not stop at any point (except during timeouts). There will be a 3-minute halftime.
- Each team will be allowed four (4) timeouts for the game. Each timeout will be considered a ½ timeout. Only two (2) timeouts will carry over from the first half to the second half. One (1) additional timeout will be awarded for each overtime period. Timeouts remaining at the end of regulation will NOT carry over to overtime periods.
- Overtime will be a two (2) minute period. If the game is tied after the first two-minute overtime period, the game will then be decided by sudden death, the first team to score 2 POINTS wins.
- Warmups will be awarded to each team for a minimum of five (5) minutes. It is important that during the warmup period coaches are completing the score sheets at the scorer's table.
- Free throw shots will be awarded based on the following guidelines. One free throw shot will be awarded for every free throw shooting situation and will count for the appropriate number of points.
  1. If a player shoots a 2-point shot and is fouled, and makes the field goal, no free throw will be awarded, but a point will be added to the score. This would equal 3 points.
  2. If a player shoots a 2-point shot and is fouled, and misses the field goal, one free throw shot will be awarded. If that one free throw shot is made, then 2 points will be added to the score and play resumes. If that one free throw shot is missed, the game immediately resumes.
  3. If a player shoots a 3-point shot and is fouled, and makes the field goal, no free throw shot will be awarded, but a point will be added to the score. This would equal 4 points.
  4. If a player shoots a 3-point shot and is fouled, and misses the field goal, one free throw shot will be awarded. If that one free throw shot is made, then 3 points will be added to the score and play resumes. If that one free throw shot is missed, the game immediately resumes.
  5. Fouled on, or after the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul, for each half, then one free throw will be awarded for 2 points.
  6. Intentional, flagrant, and technical fouls will result in the opposing team being awarded one free throw shot for 2 points. Non offending team will then retain possession of the ball (at halfcourt for a technical foul, and at the spot of the intentional/flagrant foul).
- **DURING THE LAST TWO MINUTES OF THE GAME, FREE THROWS & FOUL SITUATIONS WILL BE PLAYED WITH TRADITIONAL RULES.** (ex: shooting foul = 2 free throws for 2 points) If and only if the game is within 20 points. If not, the above rules (1-6) will remain.
- Scorekeepers will keep track of time and score. In addition to that, they will keep track of team fouls (individual fouls will not be kept), timeouts and alternating possession.
- Game basketballs should be provided by the HOME team, and it is the responsibility of coaches/teams to bring their own basketballs for warmups.
- It is fully expected that all Beach City/GPCEC Staff, facility/school staff and game officials are always treated with respect. Unsportsmanlike conduct, of any kind, will not be tolerated.
