



GAME RULES

National Federation of State High School Associations Rules applies to all games.
Top Team or 1st Team is Away, Bottom Team or 2nd Team is Home.

- Time: 2-16 minute halves with running clock. Clock will stop on free throws, time outs and the last 2 minutes of the second half. If a team is up 20, the clock will continue to run even during free throws until they get it under 20 points.
- Only 2 Coaches and players for the team are allowed on the bench.
- Player Roster must be turned in at registration table before you get coaching bands.
- Only Players that are playing should be sitting the bench.
- WE DON'T SHAKE HANDS AFTER GAMES FOR SECURITY PURPOSES.
- Free throws: Bonus at 8 Fouls & Up-2 Free Throws with 6 Fouls to Foul Out.
- Time Outs: 2-30 second time outs per half only.
- A player must play in at least one pool game to play during bracket play.
- A player can play for multiple teams in a different division under the age and grade requirements.
- If you want to protest a player or players on a team, please see the tournament director for this process. This will be a \$100 charge and will need to be done before the game that you're playing.
- All coaches should have the most current report card and birth certificate for players
- If a team is up by 25 points or more at the 2nd Half 2-minute mark or below, we will call the game as a Mercy Rule & a 30 Point Cap for victories in the Exposure App.
- **Half Time:** 2 Minutes **Warm Up Time:** 3 Minutes
- Overtime: 1st Overtime: 1 minute and clock stops on everything. 2nd Overtime will be sudden death with the first team that scores wins the game. Clock will stop on all whistles with 1 timeout only for each overtime. The fouls do carry over.
- We provide Clock, Book, Media, Security & Athletic Trainer Personnel.
- The tournament director has the right to forfeit a game if a team does not have its starting five ready to play at the given time. A five minute grace period will be given.
- If a player is thrown out, The Tournament Director will determine if the player can play the next game or for the rest of the tournament.
- **Basketball Sizes:** All Girls-28.5 Boys 1st – 5th-28.5 & Boys 6th and up-29.5
- **Pressing Rules:** 2nd-4th Grade---Teams are not allowed to press beyond half court with a 20 point lead. Once the team gets it down to 15 points, the team can start pressing again beyond half court. 5th-HS---Teams are not allowed to press beyond half court with a 25 point lead. Once the team gets it down to 20 points, the team can start pressing again pass half court.
